

The STARS Program: This program serves up to 22 Pre-K children ages 3 to 5. The program provides a very flexible and busy schedule designed to meet the needs of each child. Our early childhood programs use the Early Learning Guidelines Curriculum. This high-quality early childhood classroom has areas for children to work and play individually, in small groups, and in a whole group with the teacher as the learning leader. We call these areas “learning centers.” This program also has predictable times of day when teachers and children come together to share ideas, listen to stories, and plan their next activities. Daily lesson plans that support children’s mastery of specific competencies and objectives in the Mississippi Early Learning Guidelines are posted weekly.

Planned curriculum activities help develop the social, emotional, physical and intellectual abilities of each child.
